

RECOMMENDATIONS

Food items or Liquor, is not allowed at all. Customs doesn't consider them as household goods or personal effects. If shipped, Peruvian Customs will confiscate them, there will be high fines to be paid and the import process of the whole shipment will be delayed.

Automobiles/Vehicles: In Peru it is allowed to import new and used automobiles only under the following conditions:

- Used cars will pay
Ad Valorem 6% +
I.S.C (Impuestos selective al consume) 30% +
I.G.V (Impuestos General a las Ventas) 18% +
Tasa 9% +
Perception tax if it is 1st import: 10% of CIF value for new or used vehicle + Taxes and Duties;
Perception tax if it is 2nd import: 5% of CIF value for used vehicle
Perception tax if it is 2nd import: 3.5% of CIF value for new vehicle
- New ones 45% based on CIF value.
- Used cars for non-diplomats must not exceed 2 year of the date of manufacture at the moment of its importation to Peru.
- ONLY cars owned by diplomats will be free of duties
- Returning Peruvian diplomats after having completed their missions abroad, have the right to import only one (1) car free of duties, as long as they have acquired the vehicle in the year prior to their return.
- When shipping household goods and automobiles or any kind of vehicle in the same container, this must be clearly stated in OBL.

RESTRICTED ITEMS AND REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

Refrigerating devices (refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, etc.) If the shipper is willing to include any of these items, GIL INTL MOVERS must get from shipper the following documents:

- Technical specification manual, which must show the kind of coolant that is used. If the manual is not available, the shipper may provide a clear picture of the sticker/label that shows the name, model and brand of the device aswell as the coolant.
- The above documents are required for each refrigerating device
- The above documents and the Request form signed by client must be submitted to OTO-Peru office before the arrival of the cargo to Peru. Permission takes about 7 working days after submitting complete documents. Our fee for this additional service is USD 50.00 flat
- Approved permission must be available before arrival of goods into Peru, in order to reduce additional storage and customs charges.
- Note: Subject to confiscation, if requirements are not met. Storage and additional charges will be applied.

Telecommunication equipment (radio, facsimile & telephones)

- AM/FM radio, facsimile – Do not include.

- Additional items as Telephone/cellphone and telescope require special permission, we suggest to not include.
- Original invoice of each item.
- Subject to confiscation if requirements are not met.
- DO NOT include radio communication that uses transmission of signals by modulation of electromagnetic waves with frequencies.

Firearms and ammunitions

- Special permission/license PRIOR to arrival of the goods into Peru, obtained from the Ministry of Interior.
- Proof of ownership
- No Automatic arms are allowed.
- Subject to confiscation if requirements are not met.

Others

- Nebulizer needs a special permit from Health Ministry (DIGEMIT)
- Telescopes are not allowed as used household goods.
- Do not include **DRONES**.
- Do not include Ipad/Tablets with GSM technology.
- Do not include Wireless microphones.
- Do not include Routers
- Hoovers

CUSTOMS REGULATIONS:

All shipments are inspected by Peruvian Customs Authorities - except foreign diplomat shipments. 12% duties are assessed on household goods shipments based on the value given by the Peruvian Customs Authorities after shipment's physical inspection, which is normally below the real price of the goods.

In case of returning Peruvian citizens, Import duties are the same as for foreigners (12% duties are assessed on household goods shipments based on the value given by the Peruvian Customs Authorities after shipment's physical inspection, which is normally below the real price of the goods.), with the exception of the household goods previously exported from Peru that are free of duties, with supporting documentation (packing list, OBL or AWB and Exports Peruvian Policy, which must be stamped by Peruvian Customs Office).

In order to pay 12% of duties, returning Peruvian citizens must demonstrate a minimum of 13 continuous months living abroad, without having visited Peru for more than 30 days – consecutive or alternated – during such period of time. Otherwise, the percentage of duties to pay will be 33% of the value given by the Peruvian Customs Authorities after shipment's inspection.

Household goods and unaccompanied baggage shipments can arrive up to 180 days after owner's arrival to Peru.

In every case, used clothes, shoes and books are free of duties.

Wooden lift-van must fulfill the international regulation ISPM 15. Stamped must be shown in the wood.

Customs clearance timing: AIR: 3-4 working days & SEA: 10-12 working days, if all documentation is completed and handed to Gil Int. Movers upon arrival of the cargo to Peru. Shipper must be in Peru when the shipment arrives because the original passport is required to start customs import process.

AWB/OBL: Gil Int. Movers needs: **AIR:** copy of freighted AWB. **SEA:** Three (3) **rated** OBL, not express release OBL. If Gil Intl Moves needs to ask for the print of original OBL in Lima, Peru, the fee charged by the steamship line locally will be charged to the origin agent, we suggest sending the OBL by courier. AWB / OBL must show "Used household goods and personal effects".

- Original and signed Free Entry Resolution issued by SUNAT (only for Peruvian diplomats)
- SEA: Move authorization letter

FOR VEHICLES:

- Owner's Property Title.
- Gas Emissions Certificate and Technical Certificate (No Exceptions)*
- VIN (Serial) and Engine numbers
- 3 original endorse BL's
- Fully detailed commercial invoice (original, must show the name of the store, address, date, clear description, payments conditions) / Swarm declaration.
- Backups of the payment done for the vehicle (Peruvian customs proves the price shown in the invoice versus the payment done by the owner)
- Owner's passport copy / DNI copy
- RUC/VAT number (mandatory)
- Insurance policy (If available)
- For vehicles belonging to foreign or Peruvian diplomats, a Duty Free Resolution issued by the Peruvian Ministry of Foreign Affairs will be additionally required
